INTERCONNECT CABLES

Unique to van den Hul's cable range, (for 0.8m) The Source HB is the cheapest cable yet to use Linear Structured Carbon[®] as a conductor. Here, it is used largely as a coating, covering both the outer layer of the silver-plated copper central core and the inner layer of the silver-plated copper braid surrounding it in a coaxial design. Between the two lies a foamed polyethylene insulator.

All those conducting materials could be a disaster, but not for vdH! The Source HB is well balanced. It doesn't emphasise any aspect of the sonic package, it just plays it with minimum fuss. There is a real sense of focus and crisp accuracy, allied to excellent phase properties and a sound that is easy without being dull. If you want to add character via cables, look elsewhere, but if you want to express the system's character through cables, try 'em out.
